Ministry Description:

There is one director each for the boys and girls. With the Lifeguard students in mind, the director's focus is on the spiritual development of his/her leaders. It is hoped that mature leaders will produce spiritually mature students. The director will also be responsible for the programming, teaching calendar, special events, choosing guest speakers, preparing each weeks' meeting and clean up.

Time Required:

3 – 6 hours per week.

Location:

Upstairs in the Children's Center and occasionally off site.

Gifts, Talents, and / or Specific Skills needed in this Ministry:

The director loves to equip, encourage, and nurture adults as well as students. The director knows that the better the leaders are nurtured, the better the students will be ministered to. Must be creative and have an 'inside track' to what is going on in the lives of the students in order to plan relevant topics and 'cool' trips. Must be comfortable and confident in speaking to large groups of any age.
